

Information Session on Internet Safety

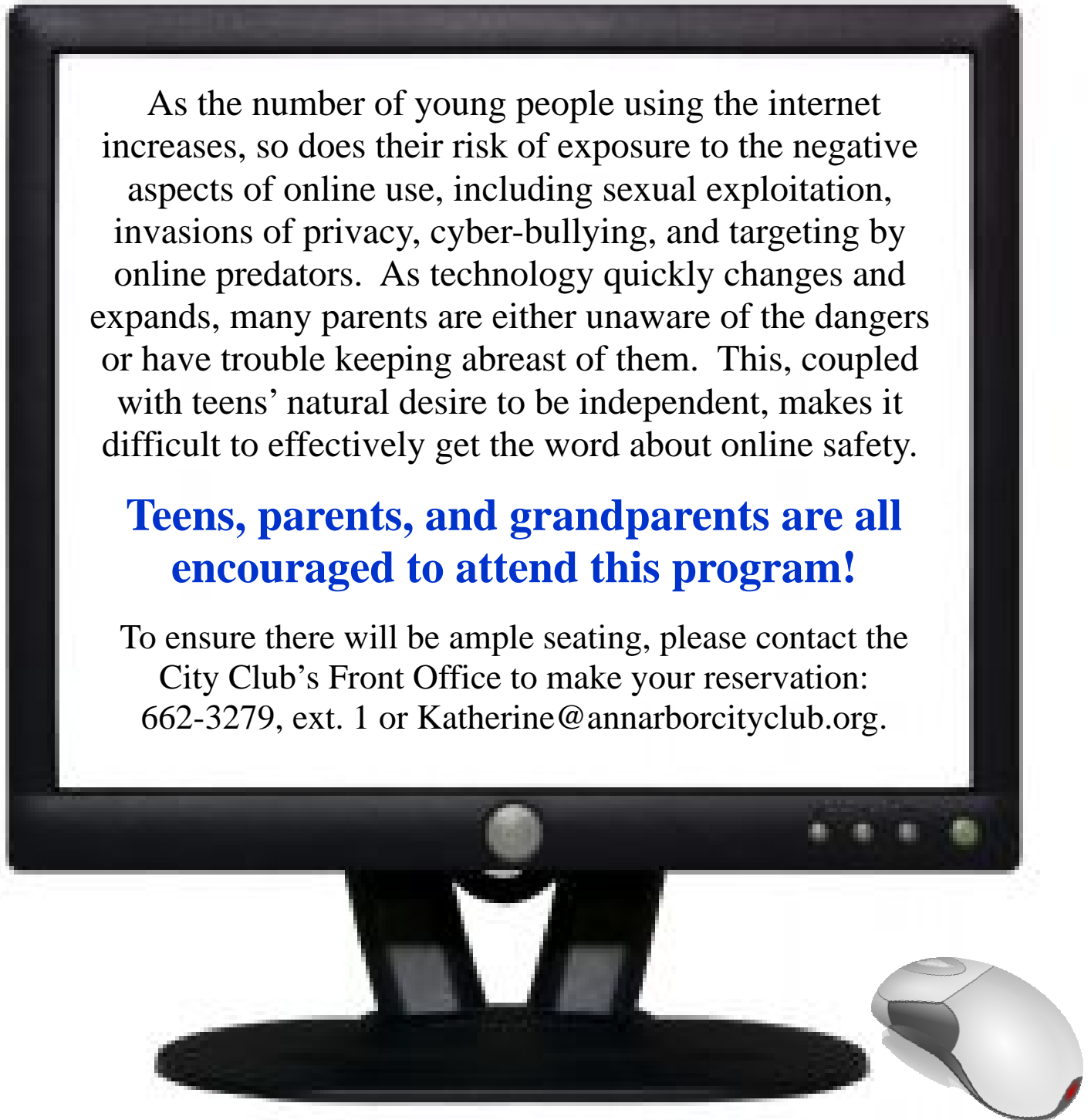
